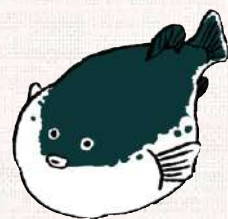
Hamamatsu Gyoza

BICYCLE RENTAL

- Location: Kanzanji Onsen Tourist Association
- How to Rent: Fill in and submit the application form at any terminal. ID is required (passport, drivers license, health insurance card, student identification, bank card, etc.) together with the application.
- Available between: 9:00 ~ 16:30
- Reference price: Adult 510 yen/day (Deposit 1,000 yen)* Children 12 and under 310 yen/day (Deposit 1,000 yen)*
- Terminal: [Araicho] • Kaikokan • Aramachi Station [Maisaka] • Bentejima Kaihin Park • Nagisaen [Hosoe] • Kiga Station [Mikkabi] • Mikkabi Station • Seto Port
- *Deposit is charged to every customer and refunded upon return of the bicycle.
- *Bicycles can be dropped off anywhere between terminals. In such cases, the deposit is returned but an additional 1,030 yen (reference price) is required.



How to use Japanese Hot Spring Onsens and Footbaths - Bathing Etiquette

Hot Spring Etiquette

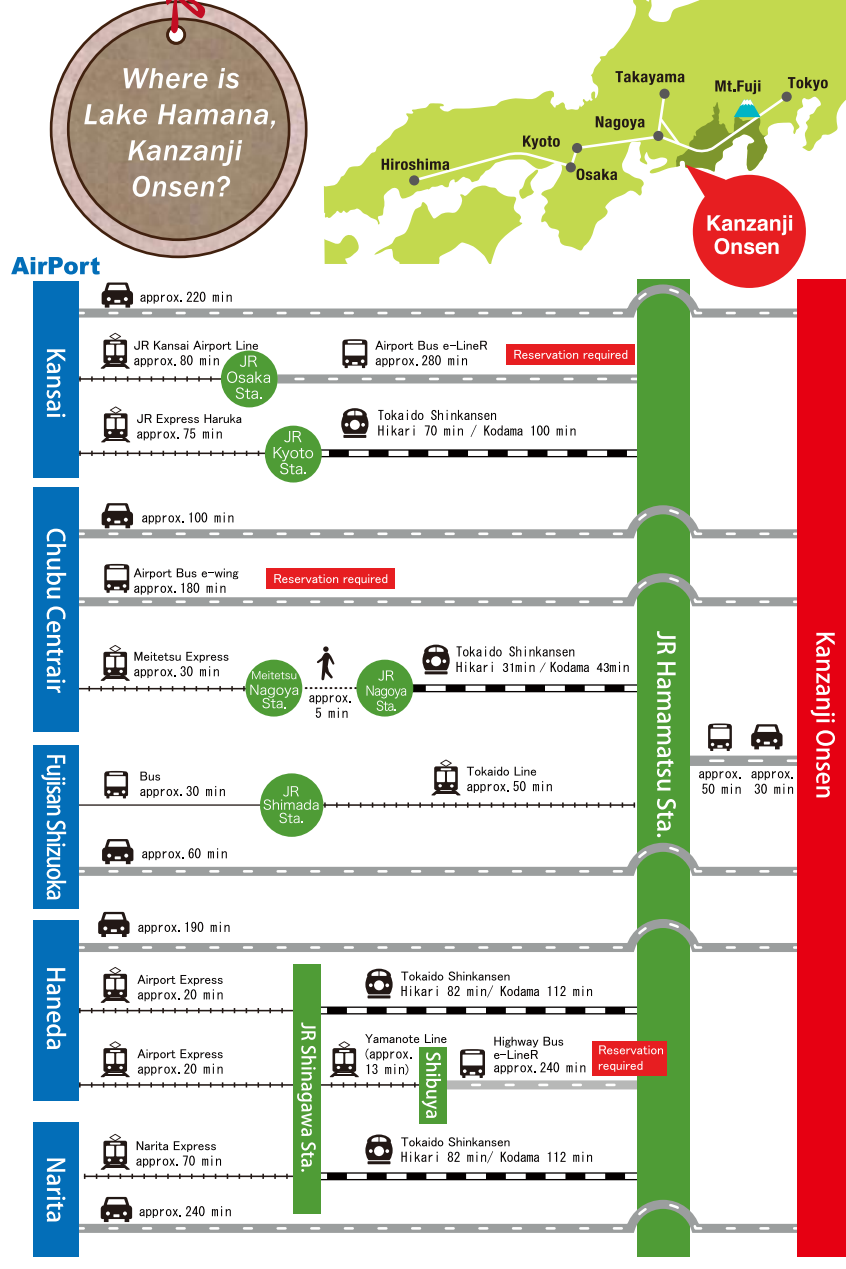
- 01 Men and women should use their own respective changing rooms.
- 02 Place your clothes and other belongings in the lockers provided.
- Take a small towel to the bathing area. Bathing wearing a swimsuit or underwear is prohibited.
- 03 Before entering the bath, clean your body by pouring hot water over it or by using a shower.
- 04 Relax in the hot water.
- If you have long hair, tie it up so it does not touch the water. Do not place the towel inside the bath. Eating or drinking in the hot spring is prohibited. Do not swim. Taking photographs in the bathing area is prohibited. The hot spring is a communal area. Please respect other bathers.
- 05 Lightly shake off any water before leaving the bathing area.

Foot Bath Etiquette

- 01 Please bring your own towel. Generally there are no towels available at footbaths.
- 02 If possible, please leave space for others to sit.
- 03 It is prohibited to put anything in the water apart from your feet. Eating, drinking, and smoking are also prohibited.
- 04 Refrain from using the footbath if you suffer from athlete's foot or any other infectious diseases.

Do you know of the custom of receiving a seal stamp at temples and shrines?

Temples give out temple seal stamps, also known as "The copied sutra submission seal", as proof that a visitor has copied sutras by hand and submitted them to the temple. The temple name, Buddha's name, and date are recorded. Today, not only temples, but many shrines give out seal stamps. Seal stamps are stamped in a book known as a "Goshuin-cho", "Nokyo-cho" or "Shuin-cho". Temple and shrine seal stamps are different from other types of tourist stamps. Please receive them as proof of worshipping at a particular temple or shrine.
