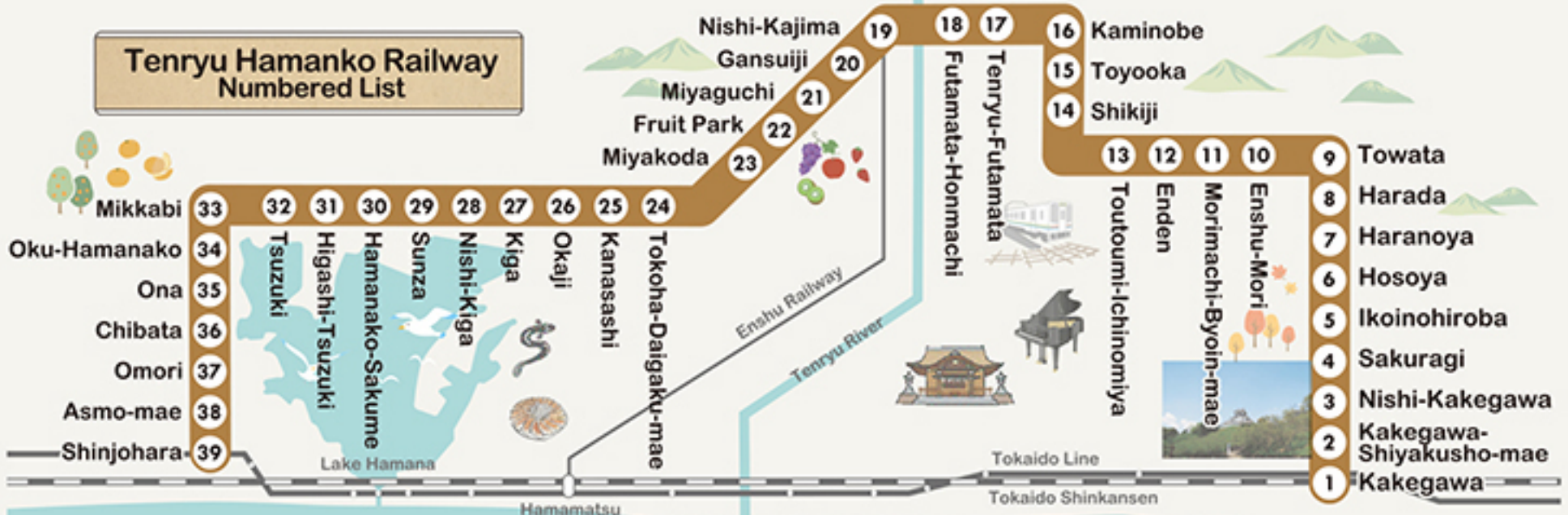
#### Hamanako-Sakume Station
